**Seniors** are required to earn **35 hours community** stewardship and have completed all Freshman, Sophomores and Junior requirements for a minimum total of 80 hours, **PLUS worked one shift at the Lord's Diner** with fellow classmates / Related Religion class: Catholic Social Doctrine / Virtues & Values: Justice, Charity
